Tree has been removed, but the road has not yet been repaired. Work has been done on the drainage channels around the Moat. Highways are aware of the dangerous state of the road and this may be fixed in 2022. We will continue to liaise with highways to keep the road safe and passable. Agreed to discuss further next month
